2010 H1N1 FLU VACCINE

On January 15th Maine General Medical Central come back to Windsor Elementary School to provide the H1N1 booster to students who received the first vaccine and provide the first vaccine in the series if your child missed the original clinic.

Children 9 and younger who have not received H1N1 influenza vaccine in the past will need two doses of vaccine given to be sure they are fully protected from the H1N1 virus. Current data suggests that children 6 months to 9 years of age have little to no immunity to the H1N1 2009 virus. The second shot is to help boost the body's response to fight off sickness. Maine General Medical Center is assisting your school by offering a booster H1N1 vaccination or first doses for children who missed earlier clinics.

There will be no charge for the vaccinations your child receives at school. The vaccine clinics are specifically meant for children who attend schools in RSU #12 district.
